the most prestigious program identifying, rewarding, and meeting the needs of gifted children throughout the Midwest.



You know your child is curious and smart. But do you know . . .

- the full extent of your child's ability?
- your child's academic strengths?
- the level of instruction your child needs to provide challenge and ensure academic growth?

And do you want your child to . . .

- gain practice on the high-stakes test(s) used for high school placement, scholarships, and college admissions?

And do you want to . . .

- gain more information to help you plan your child's academic future?
- learn about gifted programs for which your child might qualify?
- belong to an active, online community of gifted learners and their families?

Understanding your child's level of achievement is the first step. Yet grade-level state exams do not measure knowledge and skills beyond the current grade. Even popular computer-adaptive tests do not have the higher-level questions needed to tell us what gifted students are ready to learn. This means the tests have a "ceiling effect."

To combat this "ceiling effect," NUMATS uses assessments designed for older students that measure college and career readiness. Students in grades 3-6 take the PSAT™8/9, typically administered in grades 8-9. Students in grades 7-9 take the SAT® and/or ACT®, the same tests given to high school students for college admissions. The tests are administered locally on Saturday or Sunday mornings and generally take about 4-5 hours to complete.

- Throughout the process, carefully read all statements before agreeing and proceeding to the next step.
- In Step 4, identify a school if you want the NUMATS coordinator at the school to have access to your child's scores.
- Look for the e-mail we send when you submit your registration and be sure to follow instructions.

Before testing, visit MyCTD Toolbox, your password-protected online account.

- View registration details (click on student's name, then View Registration Detail).
- Access test prep materials (NUMATS Info Tab, section 2).
- Download the required student identification form (SAT/ACT Only – NUMATS Info Tab, section 3).

After testing, visit MyCTD Toolbox (click on student's name, then View Score).

- Access test scores and NUMATS percentiles.
- Review course sequence suggestions.
- Read articles on working with your school.

Throughout upcoming year, visit CTD Backpack, our interactive online community for gifted students and their families.

- Access the latest research on gifted education.
- Participate in live podcasts and webinars with experts in the field.
- Communicate with other parents of gifted students.
- Encourage your child to collaborate online with other gifted students.

A week prior to test date: Call the testing agency if you have not received a test center admission ticket.

On test day: Ensure your child takes the test center admission ticket (all tests) and student identification form (SAT/ACT only) to the test center. Both documents are required for admission to test.

Several weeks after test date: You will receive an e-mail indicating scores are available in MyCTD Toolbox. The testing agency will send you a hard copy of the score report.

April-May: NUMATS recognition certificates are mailed to the school identified in registration or to the home address if a school was not identified. Schools often hold awards assemblies in May.

August-October: NUMATS and state award ceremonies are held.
