CTD Academic Summer Camps

In-Person Programs

Day Camps at Chicago Area Sites

1-Week Academic Camps (PreK - GRADE 5)

Students participate in challenging single-week, half-day (am/pm) or all-day enrichment courses offered in a variety of subject areas. Anticipated program locations are in Chicago (South Loop Middle School), and Evanston (St. Athanasius School).

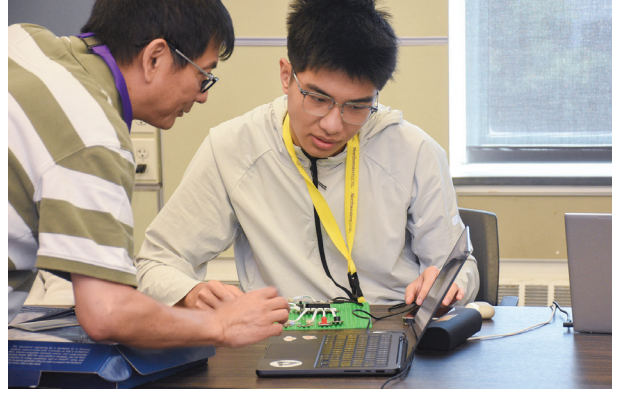
Program Dates: June 29 - August 7

Day and Residential Camps at Northwestern University's Evanston Campus

1- and 3-Week Academic Camps (GRADES 6 - 8)

Academic camps offering middle school students the choice of unique, fast-paced enrichment courses and high school honors, credit-eligible courses. Courses allow students to deeply explore specialized topics and accelerate through core subject area sequences. Classroom communities offer intellectual and social development. Afternoon and weekend activities give students the chance to forge friendships in a safe, inclusive summer camp environment. Residential camp helps students develop the independent living skills required at college.

Consecutive 1-Week and 3-Week Sessions
Program Dates: June 28 - August 7



1- and 3-Week Academic Camps (GRADES 9 - 12)

Academic camps offering high school students the choice of unique, fast-paced, enrichment, high-school honors, AP®, leadership and service-learning, college level and career exploration courses. Honors and AP® courses are eligible for high school credit through CTD. Coursework exposes students to authentic problems central to college and career pathways and offers opportunities to accelerate through core subject area sequences. Classroom communities offer intellectual and social development. Afternoon and weekend activities give students the chance to forge friendships in a safe, inclusive summer camp environment. Residential camp helps students develop the independent living skills required at college.

Consecutive 1-Week and 3-Week Sessions
Program Dates: June 28 - August 7

Available In-Person or Online

1- and 3-week Leadership Intensive (GRADES 6 - 12)

CTD's leadership courses combine academics and service learning to foster civic engagement. By integrating hands-on service with structured learning and reflection, these classes help students develop critical thinking, collaboration, leadership, and a deeper understanding of their role in the community.

One week in-person leadership classes are available for grades 6-8. Three week in-person or online leadership intensive courses, which include regular live, online class time, are available for grades 7-12.

Online Programs

Flexibly Paced Courses

4-Week Online Enrichment Courses for Families (PreK- GRADE 3)

Interactive, shared experiences for bright, curious children and their families. Guided by expert instructors, families explore fascinating topics together through hands-on home projects and lively online discussions. Courses are open enrollment.

Program Dates: July 15 - August 12

6-Week Online Enrichment Courses (GRADES 3-8)

Motivated learners explore in-depth with the support of experienced instructors. Activities develop critical and creative thinking as students engage with inspiring content that builds deeper interest. Courses are predominantly asynchronous, allowing students to learn with flexibility.

Program Dates: June 24 - August 5

9-Week Online Core Essentials Courses (GRADES 3-8)

Courses provide access to advanced content and deep exploration of core subject areas like math, science, and English. Instructors design advanced curriculum and provide individualized feedback and support. Courses are predominantly asynchronous, allowing flexibility for other summer activities.

Program Dates: June 10 - August 12

8- to 10-Week Accelerated Summer Online Honors Courses (GRADES 6-12)

Our Honors courses are excellent for students who want to explore a professional field before college. Motivated students seeking acceleration or to earn credit outside the traditional school calendar can do so in 10 weeks. Students can earn 1- or 2- credits asynchronously along side other commitments.

Program Dates: June 3 - August 14

Enrollment Dates: June 3 and June 10

8- to 10-Week Accelerated Summer Online Advanced Placement Courses (GRADES 9-12)

College Board authorized AP® courses offered asynchronously allow motivated students to expand high school options and stand out on college applications. Students have up to 10 weeks to complete these 1- and 2-credit courses.

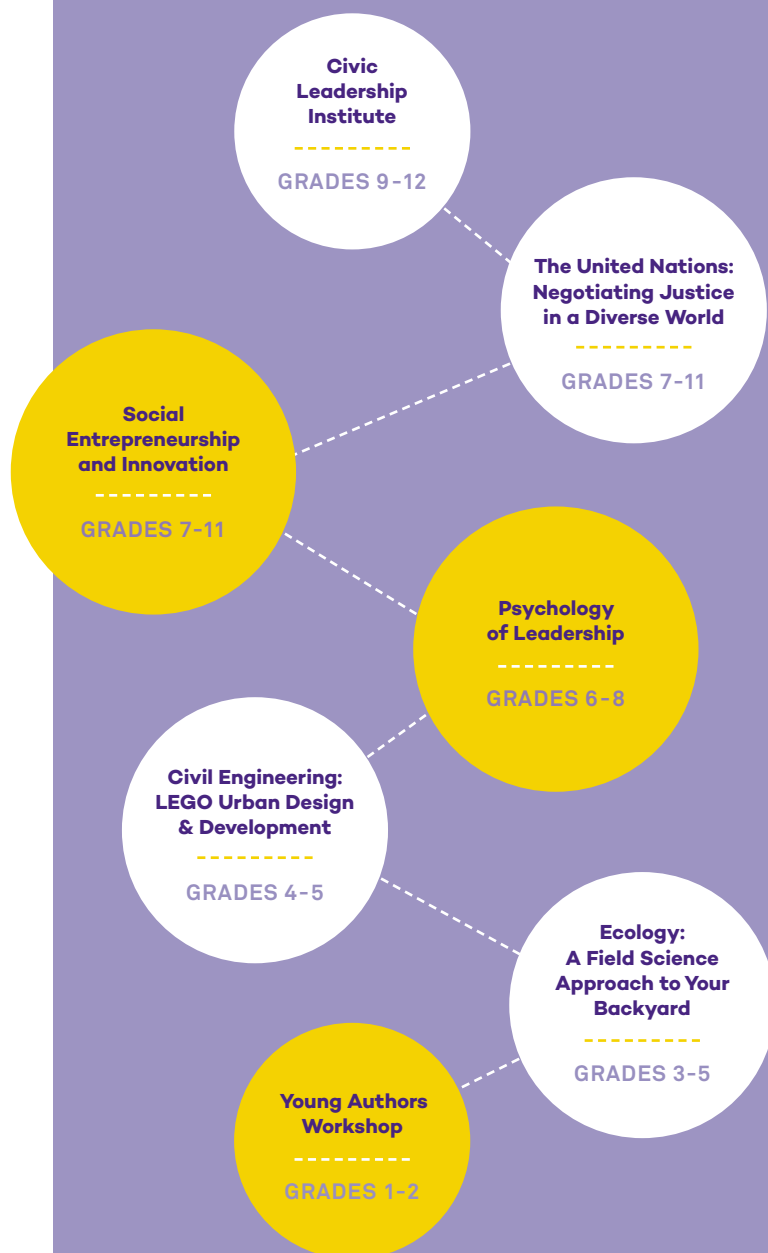
