Assessment Opportunity for Early Learners

As the parent of a child age 4 through grade 3, you may want to know more about your child's abilities and readiness for academic enrichment. And, you may want your child to participate in CTD classes, many of which need test scores for enrollment.

Good news! There are a variety of upcoming assessment opportunities available, depending on your child's age and experience:

NWEA Measures of Academic Progress (MAP)

- A group administered, computer-based test for children age 4 through grade 1
- Test dates: December 5, 7 & 12, 2019 at Northwestern's Evanston Campus, 9:00 – 11:30 a.m.
- Cost: \$65

Kaufman Test of Educational Achievement (KTEA) and Kaufman Brief Intelligence Test (KBIT)

- Individually administered tests for children age 4 through grade 3
- Test dates: ongoing, various locations around Chicago area
- Cost: \$140
